Peter Adams Young is a native of Washington, DC. Peter left the Navy in 1977 and began a career in military technology design and development. He was also an adjunct professor with the faculties of Chapman University and the University of San Diego. Retirement in 2017 provided the opportunity to focus on completing *One Hundred Stingers*, his fact-based novel about the air war over the Ho Chi Minh Trail. His latest novel *Another Death at Gettysburg* is the first in a series of contemporary mysteries set in and around Civil War battlefields. He is currently working on the second mystery in the series, which will be published later this year.
