Ecologist and writer Robert Michael Pyle has studied natural history and written essays, poetry, fiction, and science along a tributary of the Lower Columbia River since 1978. His 28 books include the Northwest classics Wintergreen, Sky Time in Gray's River, and Where Bigfoot Walks, the novel Magdalena Mountain, and a flight of standard butterfly books. The latest of his five poetry collections, The Last Man in Willapa, came out from Texas Tech Press in 2024, and the next, Swimming With Snakes, will appear from Watershed Press in 2025.
