Did you know?

The first known official celebration of Saint Valentine's Day took place in Paris on February 14, 1400

The oldest record of a Valentine is a poem Charles, the Duke of Orleans, wrote to his wife when he was imprisoned in the Tower of London in 1415, in which he refers to his wife as his "Valentine."

In 1537, England's King Henry VIII officially declared February 14 the holiday of St. Valentine's Day by royal charter. (And yes, he is the monarch who had six wives: one who died, one who survived, two who he divorced, and two who he beheaded.)
